

## Rabbi Discretionary Fund Policy

1. Mission statement – The Rabbi’s Discretionary Fund (RDF) is a fund established by the Board of the Congregation.
  - a. The monies in the fund are to be used at the sole discretion of the Rabbi for charitable purposes consistent with the synagogue’s exempt purposes, to assist individual, educational and communal needs that may be necessary to be met in a confidential manner or whose needs would bring a benefit unable to be met through other means, or whose purpose would bring benefit to the congregation.
2. Charitable contributions directed to the RDF should be made payable to The Jewish Center of Princeton.
3. Donors should receive a charitable donation letter.
4. The Rabbi should provide documentation of the disbursed funds.
5. The Rabbi should not be able to receive a tax deduction for any disbursements from the fund.
6. The fund may not be used for the personal benefit of the Rabbi or his or her family.
7. The RDF is subject to outside oversight via auditors and/or the Financial Vice-President.
